Describes how to specify a link in the content of an article

.contents

The command syntax is: <white space>.<white space><reference>~

.para

(Generally a space, followed by a dot, directly followed by a tilde and a space, then the text of the button terminated by another tilde.)

.nl For example, .quote-line .~ button~

As usual the text of the button should be the .~ article title~ or a .~ synonym~ of an article title.

The effect of this link is a jump to the beginning of the article whose title is given between the tildes.

IN THE NEAR FUTURE: .nl

We will go back the the use of the tildes (e.g. ~button~), which are easier to use and don't disturb the reading of the storyboard so much.

We now use the .quote .~ command to simplify the job of the .~ formatter~ .
